

## **Non-Circulation of Print Journals**

The Library does not circulate print journals outside of the Library. Many people have complained about not being able to obtain journal articles because journals are checked out. This problem is worsened when journals are not returned by the due date. The Library has frequently had to incur the cost of obtaining articles through interlibrary loan because journals have been checked out. Journals that are lost or damaged are more expensive and harder to replace than books. The non-circulation of journals should ensure better access to the print journals in the Library for all patrons. (Effective July 1, 2005)

## **Fines on Overdue Materials**

The Library charges \$.25 per day for overdue materials. This policy is strictly enforced. Refusal to comply with this policy may result in the loss of Library privileges.
